Finish this **before** the exchange **February 6th**. Have your artist statement written out and ready to share with the group.

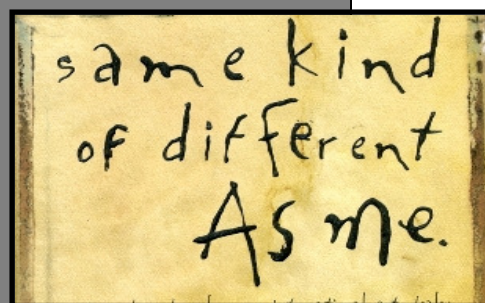
Exchange #1 at Becker High School
